Wraparound Fidelity Assessment System (WFAS) tools help track Wraparound implementation quality.



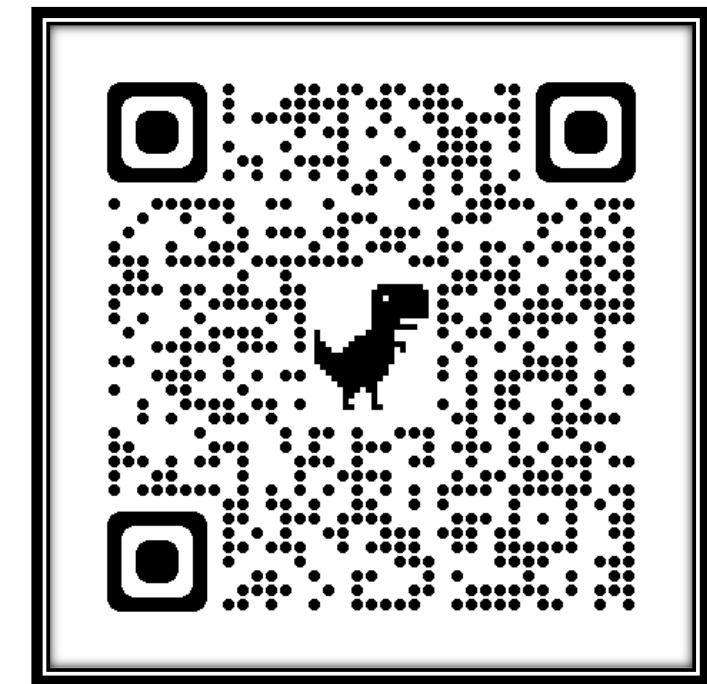
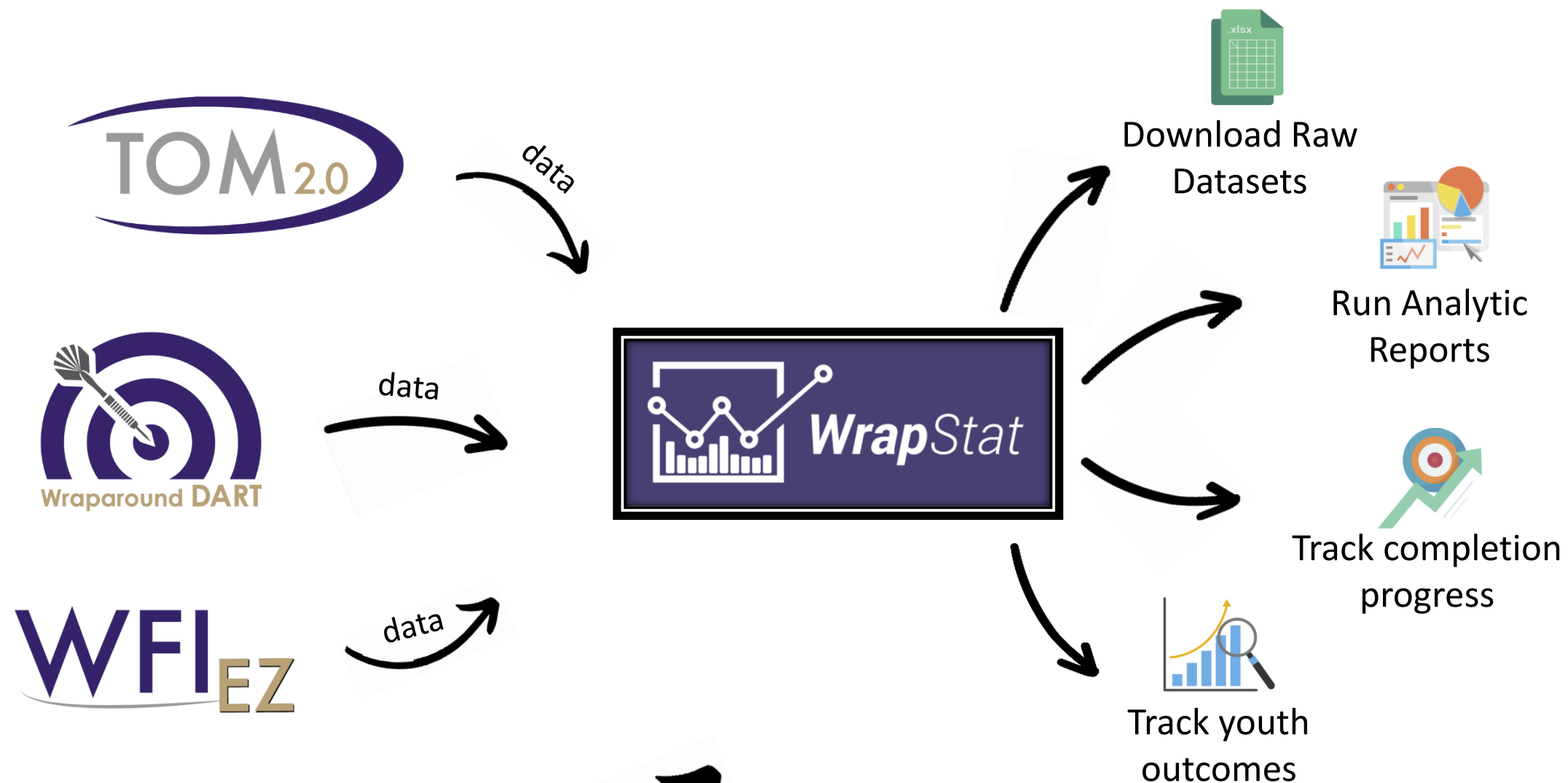

Background - WrapStat



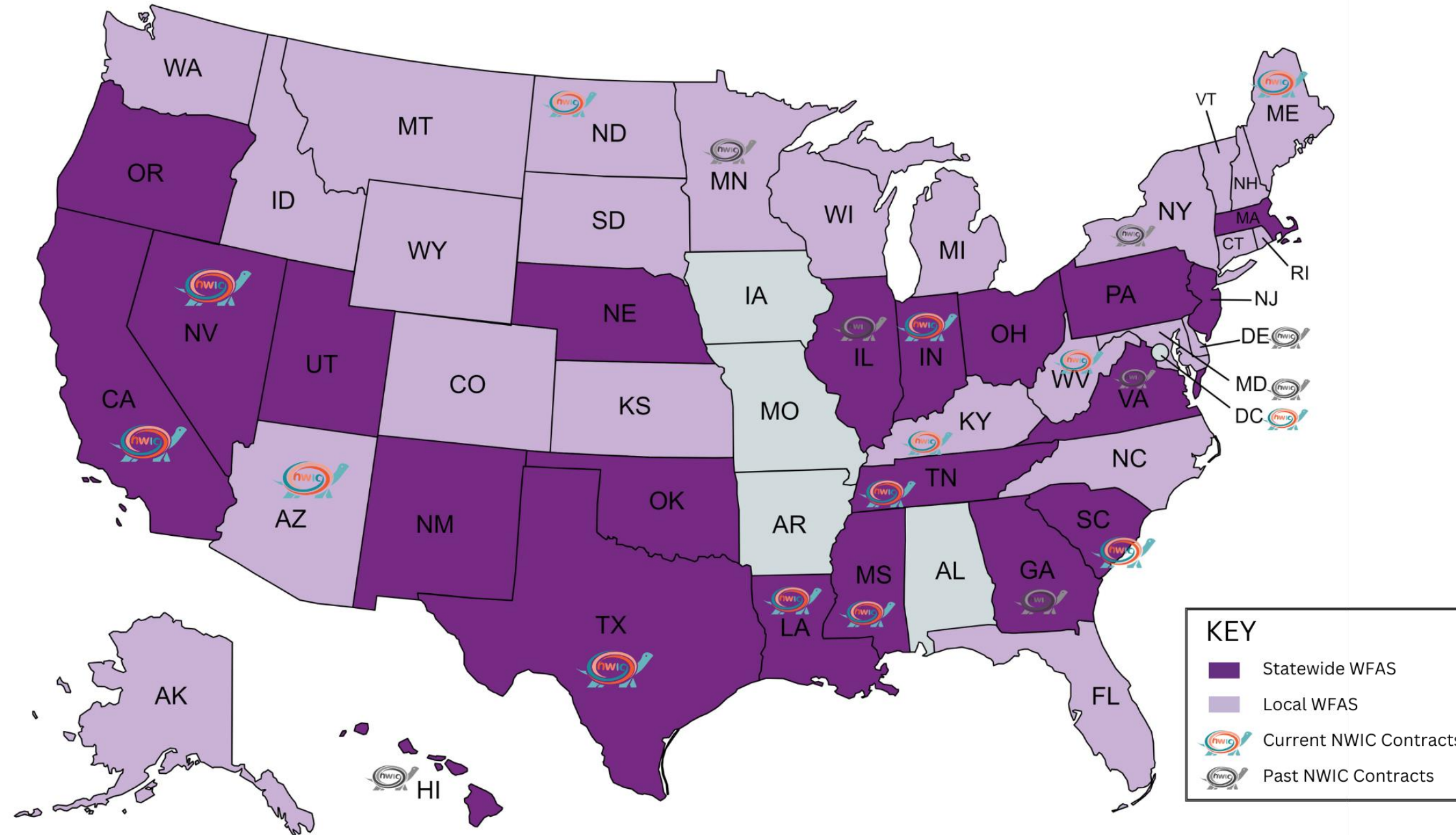
WrapStat is a data collection, management, and reporting system designed for the WFAS tools.

WFAS measures are used in nearly every U.S. state

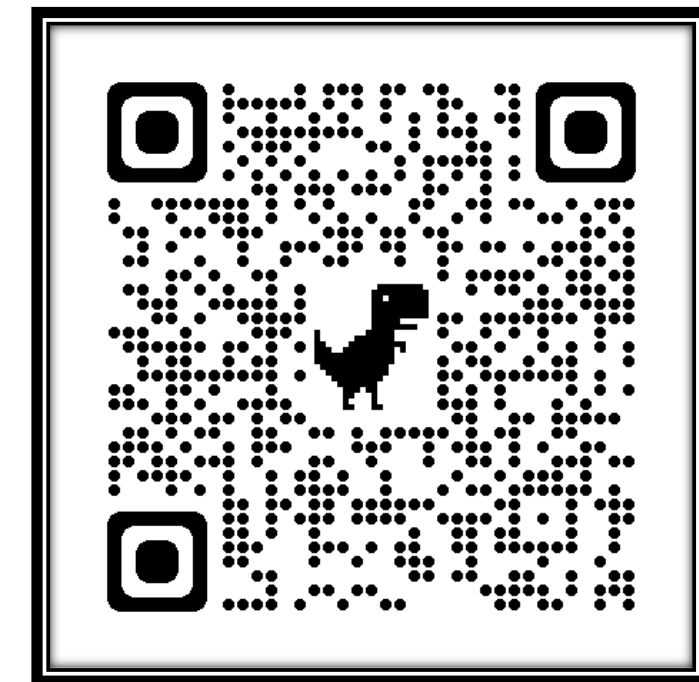


Background – More Info

 - Make the case for Wraparound outcomes



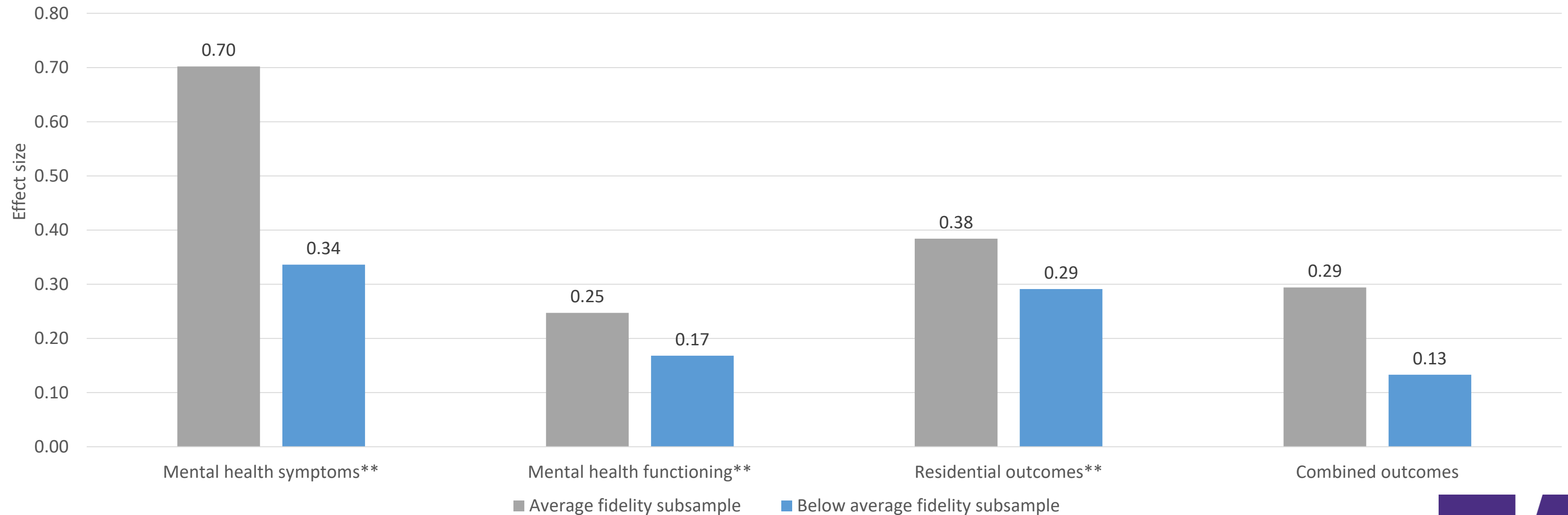

- We will work together to use the data to continuously improve Wraparound, systems of care, and family well-being.

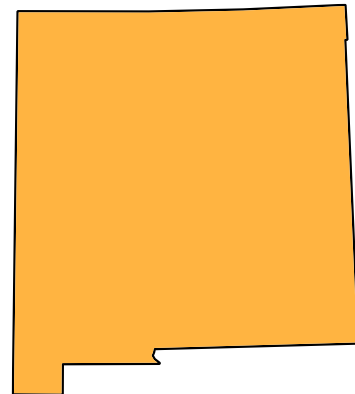

 - ▶ Share Point

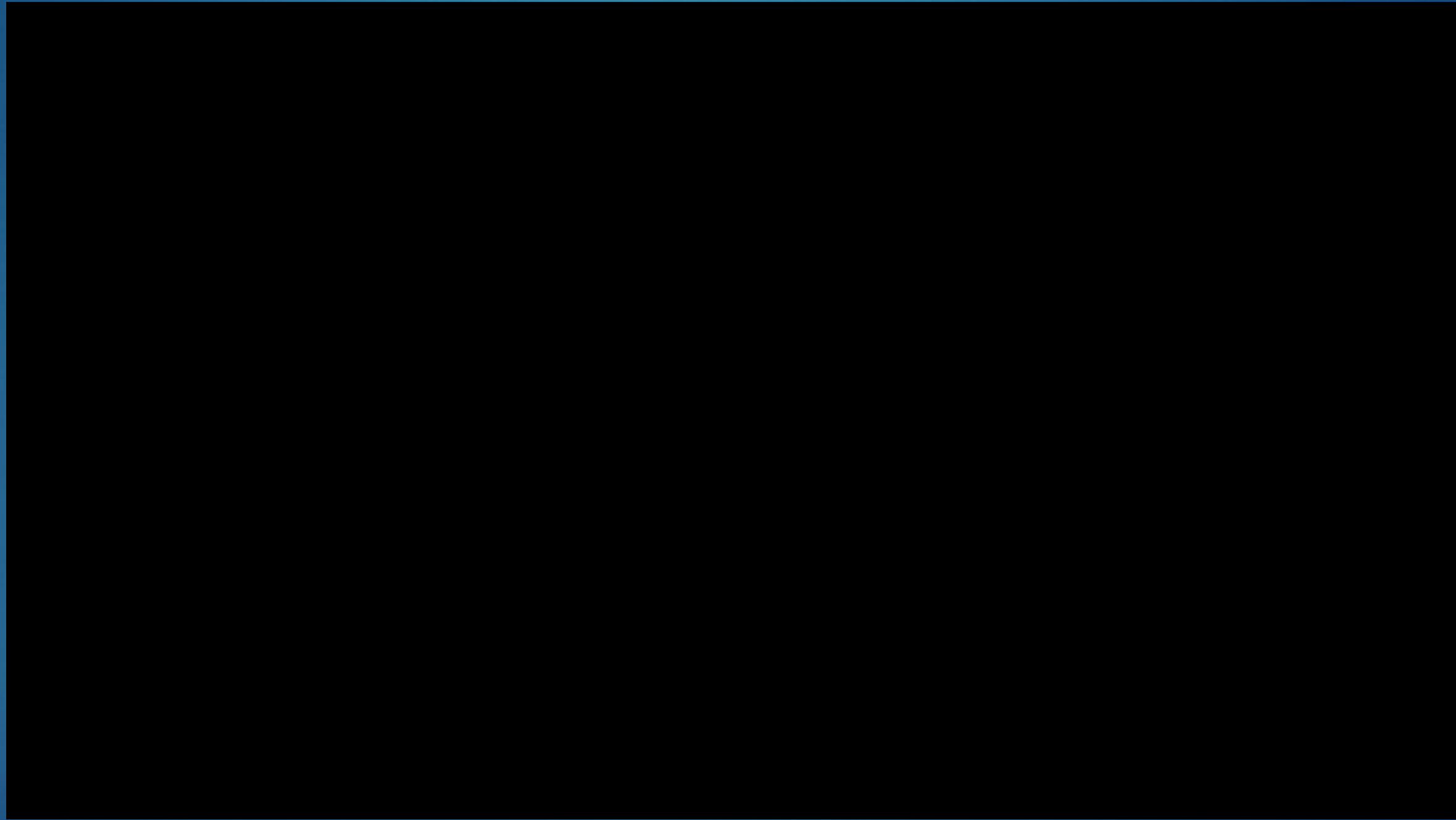


WFI-EZ

- ▶ Wraparound Facilitators contact Families not WrapStat
- ▶ Wraparound Facilitator is responsible for sharing video and handout with the family
- ▶ Families enter response into Qualtrics

Evaluation Cycles

Administrator

Sampling Default Settings

- Cycle Type: Fixed
- 3-9 months
- Distribute Evenly Across Coordinators
- Do not include recently closed families
- Do not track incentives
- Do not use the “auto send invite message”

Scheduling

- New cycles are established in WrapStat the first of each quarter

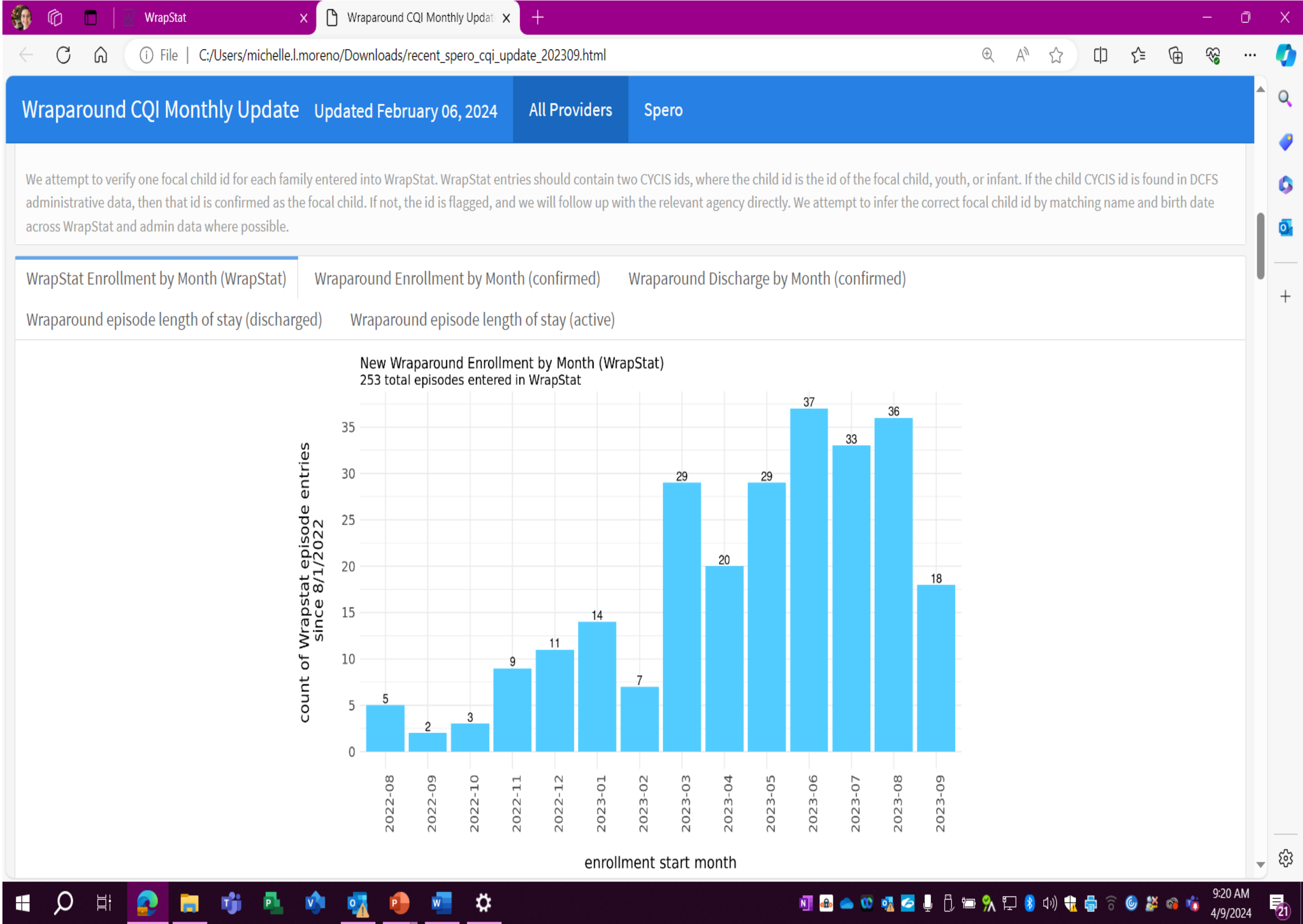

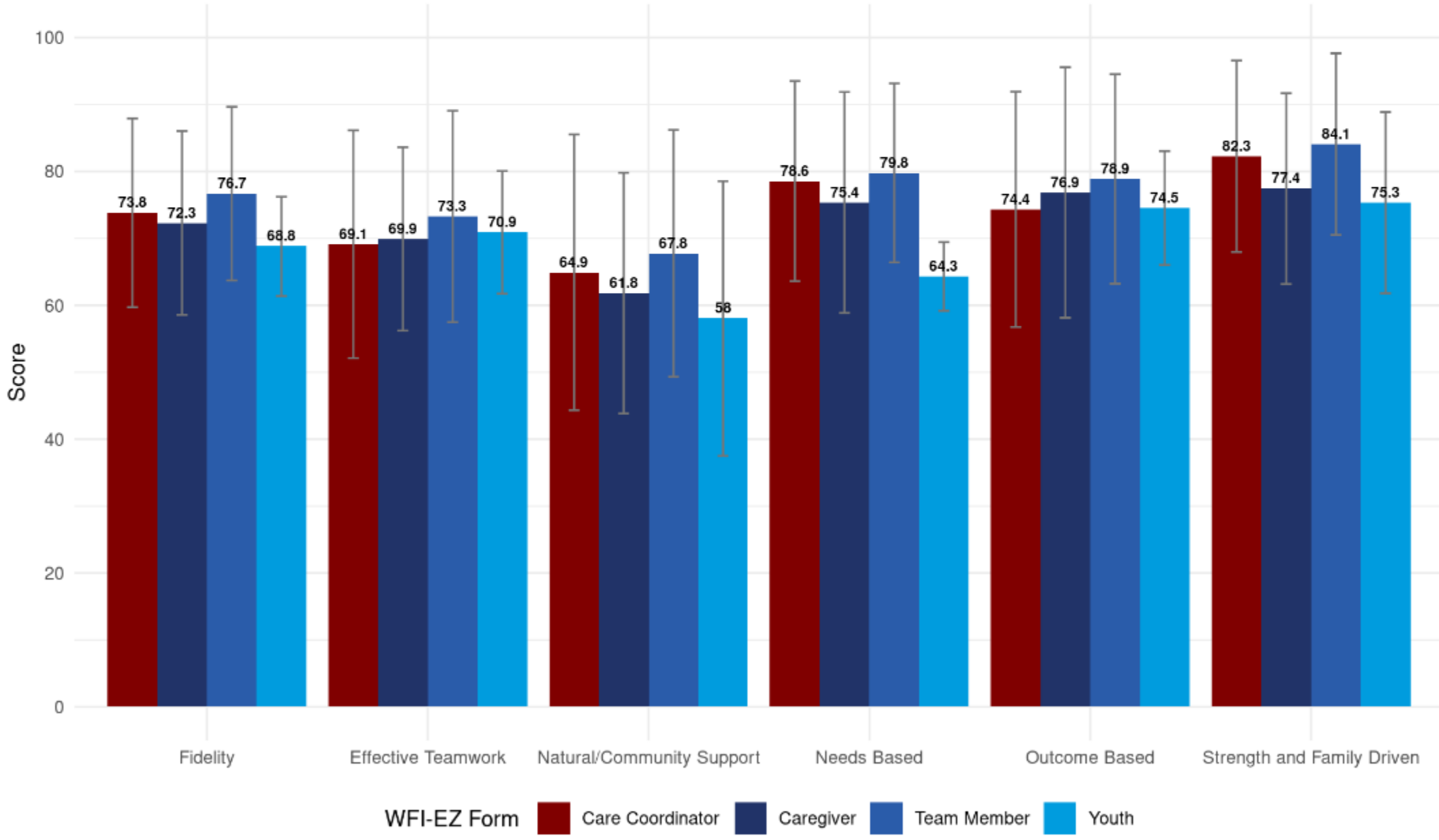

- WFI-EZ Section C is not part of fidelity score but used to calculate consumer satisfaction.

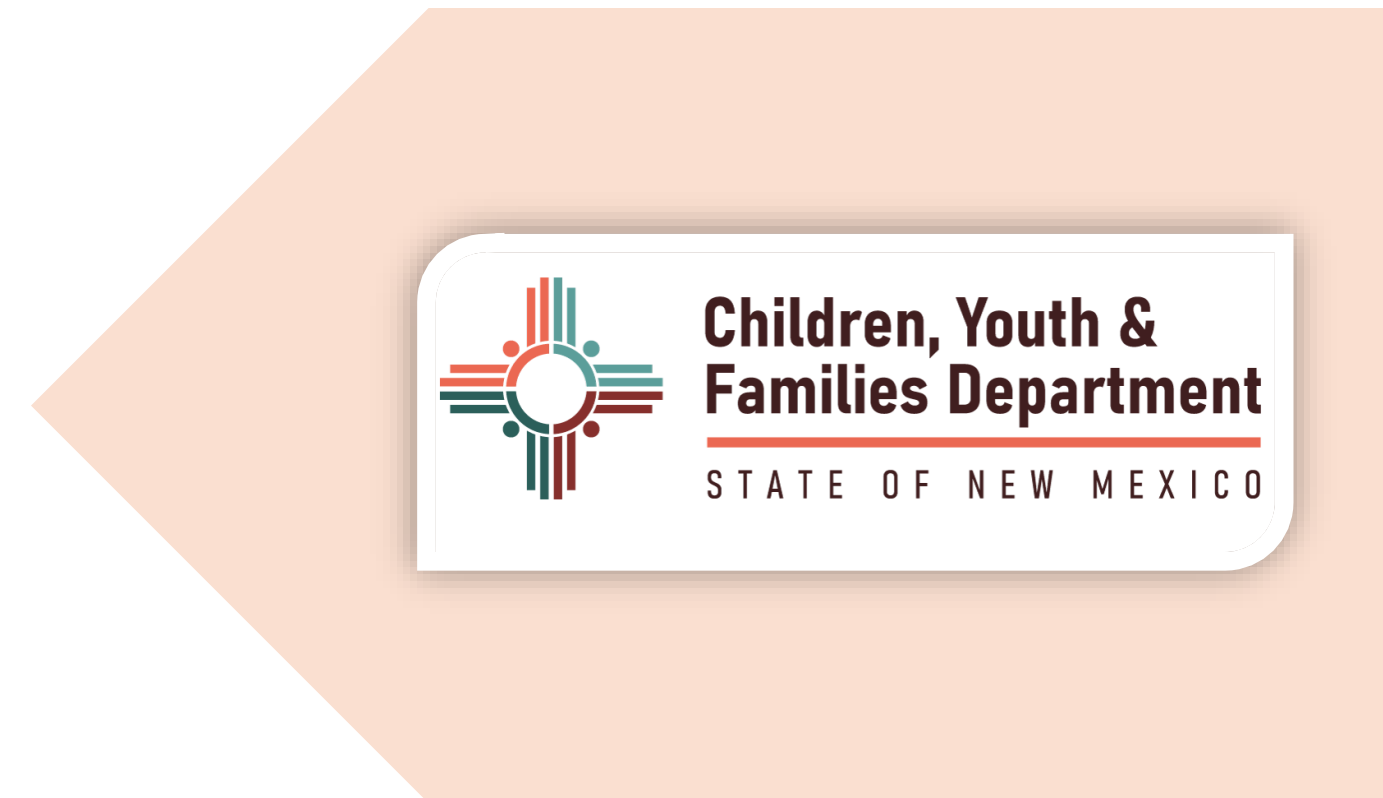
